

ٱللَّهُ لَآ إِلَىٰهَ إِلَّا هُوَ ٱلۡحَيُّ ٱلۡقَيُّومُ Allah - there is no deity except Him, the Ever-Living, The Self-Sustaining. لَا تَأْخُذُهُ سِنَةٌ وَلَا نَوَمٌ

Neither drowsiness overtakes Him nor sleep.

لَّهُ مَا فِي ٱلسَّمَاوَرَتِ وَمَا فِي ٱلْأَرْضِ

To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth.

مَن ذَا ٱلَّذِي يَشْفَعُ عِندَهُ إِلَّا بِإِذْنِهِ ٤

Who is it that can intercede with Him except by His permission?

He knows what is [presently] before them and what will be after them,





If you want to become a good student, You must obey Allah and perform salah 5 times daily without any excuses.









- 1-Salah is second most important pillar of Islam after the shahadha and it is an obligation to offer salah 5 times a day.
- 2-Allah mentioned about Salah numerous times in the Holy Quran.



3-Allah will question us about every aspect of our worldly life.



The first question that we will be asked on the Day of Judgment will be about salah.

The first thing for which the slave will be held accountable for on the day of Resurrection is his prayer; if it is good (by performing it properly and on time), then all his affairs will be good, and if it is ruined (by neglecting it), then all his affairs will be ruined. – Prophet Muhammed (s)

Narrated Abu Huraira:

I heard Allah's Messenger (s) saying, "If there was a river at the door of anyone of you and he took a bath in it five times a day would you notice any dirt on him?" They said, "Not a trace of dirt would be left." The Prophet (s) added,

"That is the example of the five prayers with which Allah will wipe out sins." Do you wish to be forgiven by Allah??
 Then we must not miss salah.

6-Offering salah is the best act in the sight of Allah.

In Holy Quran, Allah Almighty says:

إِنَّ الَّذِينَ ءَامَنُوا وَعَمِلُوا الصَّلِحَنتِ وَأَقَامُوا الصَّلَوْةَ وَءَاتَوُا الزَّكُوْةَ لَهُمْ أَجْرُهُمْ عِندَ رَبِّهِمْ وَلَا خَوْفٌ عَلَيْهِمْ وَلَا هُمْ يَحْزَنُونَ

"Indeed, those who believe and do righteous deeds and establish prayer and give Zakah will have their reward with their Lord, and there will be no fear concerning them, nor will they grieve." (Quran, 2:277)

DID YOU KNOW...?

Our salah will be invalid if we dress up against the teaching of prophet muhammed (PBUH).

- Salah is a communication between us and Allah. So we should try to wear our best dress when offering salah.
- Below are some of the rules that boys/mens must follow during salah. Let's read and understand.
 - 1. Men's clothing should cover them from the navel to the knees at the very least.
 - 2. The shoulder should be covered
 - 3. Salah can be offered in one garment if it covers the body from the navel to the knees as well as the shoulders.
 - 4-Boys should keep their dress above the ankles.





It is prohibited to lower your pants below the ankle.

DID YOU KNOW...?

Do you know how dangerous it is to wear your dress below the ankle?

Let's read three hadith about this topic.

Allah will not even look at these people on the day of judgement.


The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "There are three whom Allaah will not look at or praise on the Day of Judgement and theirs will be a painful punishment: **The one who wears his garment below his ankles, the one who reminds others of his favours, and the one who sells his product by means of making false oaths**" (reported by Muslim, no. 106)



مَا أَسْفَلَ مِنَ الْكَعْبَيْنِ مِنَ الْإِزَارِ فَفِي النَّارِ

Al-Bukhaari reported that the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Whatever of the izaar (lower garment) is below the ankles is in the Fire."

(al-Bukhaari, no. 5787)



- Dear students, did you realize how bad it is to wear pants /other garments below the ankle?
 - Our Prophet Muhammed (s) also said that such people will not even smell the fragnance of paradise.

NOTE 💉

We should also remind our friends, brothers, cousins, and even our father about this. Even though this is a minor act, it is possible that we will miss our eternal heaven as a result of this bad habit. May Allah grant us all the ability to follow this great sunnah.

- Dear boys, are you ready to follow Islamic dress code?

- The Islamic dress code should be followed in our daily life, not just when we pray. It should be followed when we go to school, when we attend a wedding, when we go shopping, and when we play.

Furthermore, we will receive numerous rewards from Allah for obeying his Commandments.

We have learned about the Islamic dress code of the boys/men.Now let's discuss about the Islamic way of dressing for girls/women.



Following are some of the most important Islamic rules of girls.

1.It should cover the whole body except face and forehands.

- 2.It should be thick enough.
- 3.It should not be transparent.
- 4.It should not be a tight fit.
- 5.It should not be decorated or ornate such as to attract the vision of opposite gender.

6.It should not be perfumed.

7.It should not resemble the dress of men.



NOTE 💉

These rules must be followed not only when offering Salah, but also when meeting other men, with the exception of blood relatives such as father, brother, grandfather, and so on. When we meet our neighbors, relatives, and other boys/men, we should dress according to Islamic standards. Even in front of our cousins, we should adhere to Islamic dress code.


